OXIDATIVE STRESS

Oxidative stress leads to an increased risk of negative health outcomes, such as cardiovascular disease and certain types of cancer. Your body needs to maintain a certain balance between free radicals and antioxidants. When this equilibrium is disrupted, it can lead to oxidative stress. So what does research say about Molecular Hydrogen and oxidative stress:

<u>"Hydrogen has been shown to protect against tissue injuries caused by oxidative stress and excessive inflammation."</u>

<u>"Evidence has consistently demonstrated that molecular hydrogen is a promising therapeutic option for a variety of diseases and the underlying comprehensive mechanisms are beyond pure hydroxyl radicals scavenging."</u>

<u>"H(2) may represent an effective antioxidant for the prevention of oxidative stress-related diseases."</u>

<u>" Thus H(2) can be used as an effective antioxidant therapy: owing to its ability to rapidly diffuse across membranes, it can reach and react with cytotoxic ROS and thus protect against oxidative damage."</u>

<u>" This review makes a case for supporting hydrogen medicine in human disease prevention and therapy.</u>"

<u>" It is not an overstatement to say that hydrogen's impact on therapeutic and preventive medicine could be enormous in the future."</u>

REFLUX DISEASE

<u>"Drinking hydrogen-rich water may protect healthy individuals from gastric damage caused by oxidative stress."</u>

<u>"The consumption of alkaline water may have therapeutic benefits for patients with reflux disease."</u>

PARKINSON

<u>"Restoring melanin function or providing supplemental molecular hydrogen might be potential treatments for Parkinson's disease."</u>



HEMODIALYSIS

RHEUMATOID ARTHRITIS
